



Directions to Punta Banda Campo Uno

Drive south from San Diego to the Mexican Border. When you get to the Border, there will be a stop light at driver height. The light will be probably be green. If it is red stop and go. Keep to the left and avoid the inspection area. This area is for declaring items you are bringing into Mexico for Mexican residences.

It is extremely rare that you will be pulled over. If you are, just answer their questions and you will be on your way.

Soon after you pass the inspection area, follow the signs to the scenic (toll) road to Rosarito/Ensenada. It will be on your right side soon after you pass the inspection area.

Follow the toll road down the coast until you get into Ensenada. There are three toll stations. The first is just after you start going south on the Coast, the next one is in Rosarito Beach and the last one is as you enter Ensenada. You will need about \$2.50 per stop. This depends on the exchange rate. Don't worry they have change in both currencies.

Before you get into Ensenada proper the road will split and you need to stay to the right. Once you enter Ensenada stay to the right and you will be on Blvd. Lizardo Cardenas. Stay on this road and you will soon see the big three sculptured heads on your right in a park. There is also a huge Mexican flag in the park. This area is also where the cruise ships come in. Keep going down the street

You will see the navy station on the right and a Pemex Gas Station on your left (2nd traffic light after the Park with the sculptured heads). At that location, you turn left.

Watch out for the stop sign at the hospital on your right. Sometimes it is covered by a tree and you may not see it.

Follow the road. A block after the hospital, turn right (it's the 2nd traffic light). It is the next major intersection. There is a shopping center on the corner you are turning, Soriana Grocery Store and Office Depot are located in it. The block you are turning onto is Av Reforma.

You are now back on Mexico One. You just stay on this road. (This road could take you all the way to Cabo San Lucas at the tip of the Baja). Follow the road for a while then take a right turn at the La Bufadora turnoff. Follow that road to the water and you are there. Keep

going past Junior's (left side), Sharky's (Left Side), and Pacifica Materials (left side). Keep going until you see a produce stand on the right.

The next right turn is the "z" road. Pass that. Horses might be on the right side of the road, pas them. Pass the LA Bufadora Hotel. You will see a large Bill Board sign (2nd Bill Board sign on the road) that says PENINSULA, turn right here.(sign points to Agua Caliente). It is a gravel road.

Follow the road bear to the end. The gravel road crosses on to a black top road. Cross onto that road. The first three lefts are for different residencies, (Fisher, Val Verde, San Martin) They call them camps here. The fourth left is Campo 1.

Make sure you Turn left at Campo 1 by the Hielo-Ice Stand. Don't drive through straight through the guard station with the cones, it's the wrong camp. Then you will see our security guards at the top of the road, the beach road.

Straight ahead of the guard booth is Karina's and Anna's house on the corner. It is a dark pink/rose colored 2-story house. They are on the first floor, open the gate and see her. They are expecting you. They have the keys and will take you to the house and show you how it works.
